
#### MK Commerce – Basic informations

- MK Commerce was established in the 1980s as one of the first private companies in Vojvodina
- From its development to the present day, trade in agricultural products has been and remains this company's prevalent activity
- MK Commerce is the founder of MK Group
- Within MK Group there are more than 40 different companies, witch main activities are: sugar industry, wheat mill facility, corn mill facilities, meat processing, agriculture and seed production, trading

- MK Commerce is a group of companies whose main products are commodities including grains, oilseeds and fertilizers
- The core competence of MK Commerce is wholesale, import and export, with annual turnover of 1.200.000 mt of different goods
- The advantage of MK Commerce with respect to competing companies in the domestic market of Serbia is its business strategy and structure – gathering points and storage capacities



#### **MK Commerce - CAPACITIES**

 The most significant storage capacities are Granexport Pančevo, with the silo capacity of 60.000 mt situated on the river Danube and Žito Bačka Kula, with the silo capacity of 50.000 mt

- As for exports, MK Commerce is the largest exporter of cereals in Serbia, which was confirmed at the recent 82<sup>nd</sup> Agricultural Fair in Novi Sad, where MK Commerce received awards for The largest exporter of cereals and The largest exporter of corn in Serbia in 2014
- Goods that are mostly exported are corn, wheat, sunflowerseed, soybean



Export of corn in 2014 – part of MK Commerce






Export of wheat in 2014 at the level of the Republic of Serbia

- MK Commerce 80% of its exports realized at parity FOB Serbian Danube Ports, mostly downstream to Port of Constanta
- In 2013 we received the award for the biggest Serbian Performer in transiting cereals through the Port Constanta
- Serbian ports, through which we have so far exported goods are Port of Novi Sad, Port of Pančevo where we have our own river-silo, Port of Bogojevo, Port of Senta on the river Tisa
- In the near future we also plan to export the goods through the Port of Sremska Mitrovica on the Sava river

- For many years MK Commerce is the biggest exporter of corn through the Port of Novi Sad
- The latest data show that since 1st of October 2014 to 31st of May this year has exported around 860.000 mt of corn through Port of Novi Sad, of which MK Commerce is exported around 195.000 mt of corn, which means that we are the largest exporter of corn from this port
